QPIX Shoots Young Filmmakers To The Stars

Award-winning children's filmmaking teacher, Clinton Isle is teaming up with QPIX the non-profit film and TV production and training company, to deliver children's holiday film courses with QPIX entering the best films into Australia's largest film festival - Tropfest.

'The point of these workshops is simple: for young people to experience success whether they choose to direct, edit, write, operate a camera or produce, they are learning new skills and applying them in a very real, industry-standard way,' said Isle.

'The outcome for QPIX's Young Filmmakers Course is very real too: the children will make a polished film that will compete at an international film festival,' says Isle.

'From the initial screening of the 'rushes', through to seeing their film screened at festivals like Trop JR, the filmmakers are succeeding, and experiencing that success with others,' says Isle.

Past student of Clinton Isle's, Silvermay Darlinson-Raines, has been a finalist at Tropfest Trop JR for 3 years running with films from Clinton Isle's workshops including; *Billy And His Dog* which she directed in 2010, *Bindiana Jones* which she directed in 2009 and *Remote* which she was camera operator on in 2008.

"Every year it's been exciting. It's good to be able to continue doing what I love and getting somewhere with it," says Silvermay.

QPIX Ltd's CEO Mr Kerry O'Rourke acknowledges Clinton Isle's expertise.

'It's fantastic to combine Clinton's specific skill in teaching filmmaking to children with QPIX's resources and experience in the industry,' says O'Rourke.
